

ORDINANCE AMENDING MONTCLAIR CODE CHAPTER 327 –VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC;

February 17, 2015
(date of introduction)

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of Montclair, that Montclair Code Chapter 327 – Vehicles and Traffic, is amended as follows:

1. Section 327-20.1 Towaway Zones; Removal of Vehicles is amended to ADD the underlined provisions:

A. Any unoccupied vehicle parked or standing in violation of this chapter in a zone identified below is deemed a nuisance and a menace to the safe and proper regulation of traffic, and any police or parking enforcement officer may provide for the removal of such vehicles. The owner shall pay the reasonable costs of the removal and storage which may result from such removal before regaining possession of the vehicle.

B. Towaway zones:

(1) Public parking lot bounded by Walnut Street and Depot Square adjacent to the Walnut Street railroad station.

(2) Every designated on-street or off-street handicap parking space pursuant to section 327-24.

(3) Parking spaces reserved for mobile vendors pursuant to Section 337-4(D)

C. This section does not limit the authority to remove vehicles pursuant to any other provision of this chapter, or any ordinance or statute.

2. New Section 327-18.1-- Spaces Reserved for Mobile Vendors, is added as follows:

327-16.2-- Spaces Reserved for Mobile Vendors

- a. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Code, no person shall park in a parking space reserved for a mobile vendor pursuant to Chapter 337 during the time period indicated therein, other than a mobile vendor holding a valid permit to occupy said parking space.
- b. At all times when the parking space is not reserved for a mobile vendor, the parking regulations applicable to the block and side where the space is located shall apply.
