

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING MONTCLAIR CODE CHAPTER 327—VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE III—PARKING, STOPPING AND STANDING TO CREATE A HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACE ON WILLIAM STREET

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of Montclair, that Montclair Code, Chapter 327, Article II, be amended as follows:

§ 327-24 (A) is amended by adding the following location:

Street Name	Side	Description
William Street	North	From a point 108 ft. east from Valley Road to a point 20 ft. east therefrom

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that § 327-24 is amended by adding the following new subsection:

§ 327-24 (C) Regulations For Situating an On-Street Handicapped Parking Space Adjacent To A Residence

The following criteria and procedures shall govern the establishment of a handicapped parking space on a residential street:

1. The handicapped parking space (HPS) must be requested by or on behalf of a person residing on the subject property who has been issued a currently valid handicapped parking permit.
2. The residential property adjacent to the HPS is located must be without a driveway or available off-street parking.
3. No other HPS's can be located within 200 feet of the proposed HPS.
4. The HPS will be removed if and when the person for whom the permit has been issued no longer resides on the property.
5. The requestor must submit an application for the HPS, and an annual renewal statement attesting that the requirements for an HPS continue to be met.
6. The HPS cannot be situated where parking is prohibited.
7. The HPS must comply and be established in accordance with N.J.S.A. 39:4-197.6.

This ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
