You may already be employing some of these practices. Use this checklist to determine your current senior-friendly features and get ideas for becoming more senior-friendly.

1.	Is the entrance welcoming?
	☐ Store name is clearly visible
	☐ Entrance is clearly marked (push/pull, in/out, use other door, etc.)
	☐ Hours of operation posted
	□ Greeter
	□ No physical barriers
	☐ If physical barriers exist, are they clearly identified?

2.	Is the store environment safe and comfortable?
	□ Bright, natural light
	□ Non-slip flooring
	☐ All areas of store are well lighted
	□ Barrier free access to all areas inside store
	<ul> <li>If sound system is used, it should be loud and clear enough to be heard but not too loud or distorted</li> </ul>
	☐ Minimize music, and consider the style
	☐ Aisles are wheelchair accessible, clear of obstructions
	☐ Elevators or escalators are safe, in good repair.
3.	How is merchandise displayed?

	☐ Stock items displayed on shelves are within easy reach
	☐ Hanging items are easy to access (at arms length, not overcrowded)
